As you know, DCPS planned to make a decision by the end of the calendar year about the final direction of the Maury modernization. However, we will not be making such a decision in December as originally communicated because we would like to consider more options and meet with the Maury community. We apologize for the delay.

Given the anticipated growth in student enrollment, DCPS and the Department of General Services hired an architect to complete a feasibility study, looking at different construction options to create a school that can serve the Maury community. We would like to review the feasibility study, the challenges of the small lot, and the options currently being explored by DCPS at a school community meeting on **January 12th at 6:00 p.m.**

This is an opportunity for DCPS and DGS to hear from you about the planned modernization, and we hope you will join us. We have a shared goal to make sure we have a building that meets the needs of the students, staff, and families, and we want to engage with you to develop the best possible modernized building.
