1. Budget Review

CAG reviewed the draft budget. CAG has requested additional funding for a third 3rd grade teacher.

Two options were voted on for 2017/2018 school year:

- Option 1: (Status Quo) Increase class sizes to afford reading teacher and science teacher. Combo K / 1 or Combo 1 / 2
- Option 2: Eliminate either reading teacher or science teacher.
  - Go down to 0.5 FTE for science teacher
  - Maintain 1.0 FTE reading specialist
  - Eliminate permanent substitute teacher
- LSAT voted 9 to 3 in support of Option 2

3. Transportation Safety

Amber provided an update on the transportation safety initiative.

- a. There will be two safety patrol officers.
- b. Parent volunteers to work with Patrick and Amber on reconstituting safety patrol. 30 minutes in morning; 30 minutes in afternoon. Safety patrols are 5th graders. Plan walking / bicycling / bus caravans with planned departures. 1 or 2 parents per grade.

4. Volunteer Tutor Outreach

Amber reported that the volunteer tutoring program is going well.

5. School Modernization Letter to Chancellor

Amber presented the draft letter and table to Chancellor regarding modernization. One suggestion for the letter was to add an “ask” that requests the Chancellors endorsement and support to ask the Mayor now to fully fund the “Best” solution.
