Budget Updates (final submission): CAG

Recommendations per executive committee re: shortfall for upcoming school year: need for a new aide for the 1st grade/2nd grade split.

Progress Update on Chancellor/School Goals: David Friebele

Last school year 13% students from 2nd-5th grade were two years below grade level. This school year 6.8% students from 2nd-5th grade were two years below grade level.
Students arriving post Oct 5 are not included in the current school year PARCC scores, but are being offered resources such as Math Academy and tutoring.
iReady assessment as of Jan, 30% proficiency in 2nd grade but this data was pre-tutoring

Transportation Safety: Amber Gove

March 10 meeting with DDOT—raised crosswalk will be installed (possibly this summer) on Constitution Ave., 12th Place, Warrant St. and possibly C St.
Amber Gove and David Anspacher will continue to encourage DDOT and DCPS to work together to have a more comprehensive plan as part of the modernization.
Routes will be produced for bike train and walk bus for EH commute.
Safety Patrol will be formed this spring and utilized for both internal and external building traffic flow—this may include Bravo Team. We will make an effort to have a diversity of students.

Volunteer Tutoring: David Friebele

Tutoring is going well—4 students away from 50% proficiency. Tutoring is being provided to students in need from 2nd-5th grade.
Currently utilizing about 50% of parents who have volunteered to tutor.

PTA Update (including Modernization): Shannon Von Feldon

Per DCPS, modernization is still “on Schedule” but contractors have yet to be chosen.
CAG will meet this Wednesday with faculty to discuss swing to EH and staff feedback regarding one move vs. two moves and a start date of Dec. vs. June.
